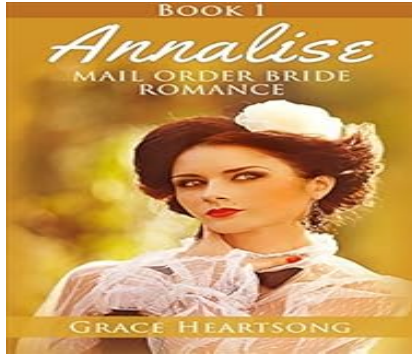

I look for and devour literary meals. Personally I feel Ms. Heartsong should combine Book 1 and Book 2. Ms. Heartsong does well with developing her characters. We definitely get to know Annalise.
