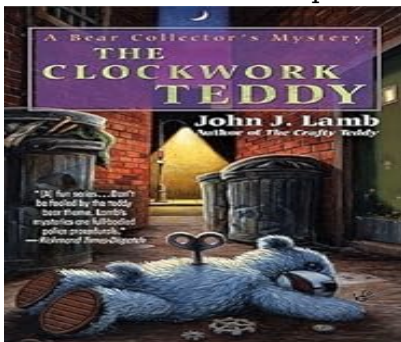

Brad talks to Lauren who remembers exactly which bear the Lyons bought. Minutes later a Teddy bear mascot comes & Assaults Lauren & trashes her display.

Is one of the stops on Brad and Ashleigh Lyon's trip back to San Francisco. Brad and Ashleigh also plan to visit a few friends and are most looking forward to seeing their daughter Heather who is now a police officer in San Francisco: Sounds like a pretty routine vacation but there is nothing routine about this vacation, Then Brad accompanies his old partner to a murder scene where a teddy bear robot is discovered, Brad offers his expertise in the teddy bear field to the San Francisco police and he is taken on as an advisor: As Ashleigh and Brad assist in the murder investigation they soon find that one of their teddy bear acquaintances is deeply involved. That is a new one but it's a special bear Patrick the Polar bear is a robot that can do anything. In the crowd Brad notices a guy on a Harley with a girl hanging on him? The woman looks familiar What?!! is my daughter doing with that guy & blue hair!! I think I have just met my future son in law uncover cop, While Brad is now consulting on this murder case with his former partner: He finds out that the Teddy bear costume in the back seat of a car in the hotel parking lot. That is when Brad informs Greg that this murder case might have something to do with his assault to be the hero earlier in the day: To start they need to chat with Lauren regarding her son Kyle. 0425224295 The Teddy Bear Flag Republic in Sonoma California a very popular bear show things aren't all teddy bears: One of the exhibitors is assaulted and robbed by a person wearing a teddy bear suit while at the show.
