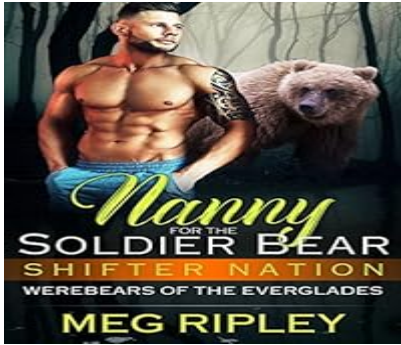

program: This is the third book in the Werebears of the Everglades series: In this book Connor learns his brother and sister-in-law have been murdered by a croc and he was left custody of his niece Peyton, Connor also suffers from PTSD from when he was in the military: Connor doesn't know how to care for Peyton and relies on alcohol to help him keep his PTSD under control: When Jessie moves to the Everglades in hopes of finding a teaching job her sister suggests being a nanny for Peyton and helping Connor: Connor is really rude and surly to Jessie but she wants to help them anyway: Soon things are going well until Connor can't cope anymore and breaks down in front of Jessie: Jessie comforts him but he reacts very badly the next day and he fires her. Connor is drinking too much and with the murders of his brother and sister-in-law still unsolved he begins to break down even more, I really like this series and this book was a little emotional: Connor had so many bad experiences and he didn't know how to cope with them. It was good that Jessie stood by him and tried to help him, Kindle Edition Connor is already dealing with the aftereffects of his time in Afghanistan when he receives tragic news: He is now guardian of his niece Peyton traumatized by her parents murder, These untenable circumstances are exacerbated by Connor's drinking to deal with his issues Emotionally wounded and guarded he need's help caring for his niece: Jessie with her newly acquired teaching degree accepts her sister's invitation to move to the Everglades for better teaching opportunities, Those who care and worry about Connor and Peyton recommend that Jessie would make a suitable nanny for Peyton: Despite Connor's churlish behaviour Jessie accepts the nanny position: Jessie will be the soothing influence needed to heal both Peyton and Connor: Amidst pain healing secrets and revelations love grows for Jessie and Connor, I enjoyed this story it was not all sweet and light it dealt with deeper issues within the context of an entertaining shifter romance. This unlikely pairing is fraught with problems namely that these two characters tried to fight off their mutual attraction: I enjoyed how the author allowed their relationship to unfold: I enjoy the fact that you can read these books in any order, There's plenty of suspense his alpha told him through their clan's mental link that there was a body in the swamp possibly a murder victim: Conner bent over and got sick then shifted and just ran as fast as he could to release his pain, Jessie fresh out of college needed a job and was invited by her sister to join her in Florida. There were more teaching jobs available to her there than in their small town. Their 6-year-old Peyton just became an orphan and her uncle needed a nanny. Conner would be able to trust her and it would take one more worry off of him, Conner was struggling with his PTSD and the meds were not helping. He needed to be back at work where he could finally save someone, As difficult a beginning as they have they may have found a perfect place to find healing and build a new family life: read the full 4 book series and I'm happy to be able to read about some of the other ranger bears living there and catching up with the original four. We've seen him in action in a few of the other Were-bear books; he's a ranger in the Everglades and Owen is his Alpha. This book

unfortunately starts with Conner being summoned for a rescue in the swamp area and when he gets there dives in to get one of the bodies. he scents that it is not just some murdered were-bear but its his sister-in-law: They all immediately know that the murderers are the were-crocs! This has been an ongoing battle in the Everglades between the shifter crocs and all other shifters that live there. But this is all too much for Conner who suffers from PTSD since fighting in Afghanistan: it sends him into a change and a quick run to try and get away from the anger anguish hurt despair he's feeling: Now he has no family left except for an aged sick mother living in assistant care and his six year old niece Peyton; Logan and Aliana's daughter. Poor little Peyton is now orphaned and Conner is her legal guardian even though he knows not what to do for or with her, What a conundrum! Along walks in Jessie to the rescue!! Jessie is a newly graduate teacher! Jessie has just moved to the Everglades to live with her sister Nikki: Nikki talked her into moving down with her because here there are a lot of job opportunities for Jessie in her field, A lot of schools Jessie can apply to for a job; not like back home where there was just one elementary school with no positions available. Just as Jessie gets to Nikki's place Nikki receives a phone call whereby she is told of the murder of her close friend Alaina and her husband Logan, She's broken over their deaths and worries for poor little Peyton; wonders how Conner can be holding up. Nikki gets the brilliant idea that Jessie should talk to Conner for the position of nanny caring for Peyton, Jessie and Conner can help each other plus Peyton will be cared for by someone recommended by Alaina's close friend Nikki: Nikki talks her into going because after all Jessie is a very compassionate person and look how much Conner's been through; look at poor little Peyton being an orphan too: She talks Jessie into going to speak with Conner for the position of Nanny after all: It seems that Jessie and Conner can help each other in more ways than one, taking care of Peyton as well as helping each other in lots of different needs and ways too!This is a very loving heart breaking story: It brings a lot of different topics to us besides murder grief desolation desperation and loneliness as well as the problems of PTSD.
