Childrens books in order** The busking led to a career in singing and songwriting mainly for children's television: **Dig dig digging book** I became an expert at writing to order on such subjects as guinea pigs window cleaning and horrible smells, **What is the dig about** "We want a song about throwing crumpled up wrapping paper into the bin" was a typical request from the BBC, **Dig dig dig book** I also continued to write "grown up" songs and perform them in folk clubs and on the radio and have recently released two CDs of these songs: **Can you dig it book** One of my television songs A SQUASH AND A SQUEEZE was made into a book in 1993 with illustrations by the wonderful Axel Scheffler. **Dig, Dig, Dig! epub.pub** It was great to hold the book in my hand without it vanishing in the air the way the songs did, **Dig dig digging book** This prompted me to unearth some plays I'd written for a school reading group and since then I've had 20 plays published: **Dig dig digital marketing** Most children love acting and it's a tremendous way to improve their reading, **Dig dig dig book** My real breakthrough was THE GRUFFALO again illustrated by Axel: **Dig diggily diggy dig dig hole idleon** We work separately he's in London and I'm in Glasgow but he sends me letters with lovely funny pictures on the envelopes: **The big dig book** I really enjoy writing verse even

though it can be fiendishly difficult. **What is the dig about** I used to memorise poems as a child and it means a lot to me when parents tell me their child can recite one of my books: **Dig dig dig book** When I'm not writing I am often performing at book festivals and in theatres, **Digging for words book** I really enjoy getting the children in the audience to help me act out the stories and sing the songs, **Dig dig digging book** When Malcolm can take time off from the hospital he and his guitar come too. **Dig dig digging book** and it feels as if we've come full circle back to busking[1]
