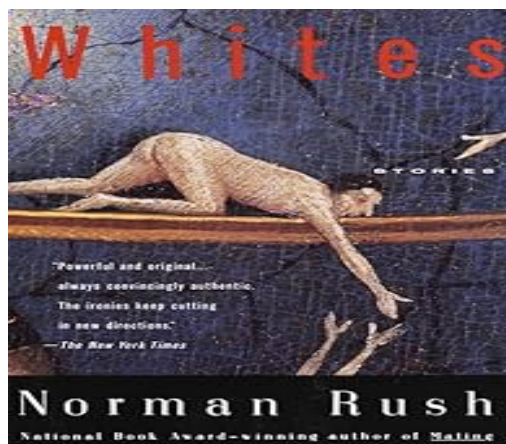


Whites By Norman Rush By Norman Rush
